A. Proposed Vigil Steps

- 1. Light a candle on the altar to symbolize the presence of "Jesus, the Source of Light.
- **2.** Kneel down as a family ("act of sacrifice"), if possible.
- **3.** Do vigil for 3 days (*triduum*) hourly from 6AM 12MN.

1. Apostle's Creed

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, Our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

2. Our Father

Our Father, Who art in Heaven. Hallowed be Thy name; Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

3. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

4. Doxology (Glory Be)

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end Amen.

5. Fatima Prayer

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those in most need of your mercy.

Miraculous Medal Prayer

O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee.

Divine Mercy Prayer

Jesus King of Mercy, we trust in you.

6. Act of Contrition

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you, and I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of heaven and the pains of hell, but most of all because I have offended you, my God, who are allgood and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace to confess my sins, to do penance and to amend my life. Amen.

C. Deliverance Prayers

1. Prayer to St. Michael

St. Michael, the Archangel, defend us in the day of battle. Be our safeguard against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke Him, we humbly pray, and do You, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the other evil spirits, who prowl through the world, seeking the ruin of souls. Amen

2. ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

O Heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore you; I love you, and with a lively sorrow for my sins, I offer you this poor heart of mine. Make me humble, patient, pure, and wholly obedient to your will. Grant that I may live in you and for you.

O most merciful Jesus, we consecrate ourselves today and always to your Most Sacred Heart. Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make our hearts like unto yours. Protect me in the midst of danger, comfort me in my afflictions give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, your blessing in all I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen.

3. HEALING OF BODY, MIND AND SPIRIT

Dear Lord,
I know that there is no sickness that you cannot heal,
You know all things,
you can do all things,
and you love (Name of person).
With faith in your promise that whatever we ask in prayer,
you will grant us if it will be good for our soul.
We come before you to ask for healing of body, mind, emotions, and spirit.

Touch us now where we are hurting most.
Only you know what kind of healing we need most right now.
Let the grace of your divine love flow and spread to the different parts of our body reaching the inner recesses of our being.

Comfort us in our pain and anguish. Correct any malfunctioning of our body organs. Melt with your healing love any abnormal growths. Arrest all further spreading of all sick cells and replace them with healthy cells.

Root out all unresolved hurts, resentments, fears, and feelings of despair and frustration.
Heal all painful memories and repercussions of traumatic experiences.

Grant us the grace to accept this trial and suffering as a share in your own sufferings and offer this for the salvation of our soul and those of our family and loved ones. Forgive us for all our sins and fill us with your love, peace, joy, kindness, and generosity. Let us realize the deeper meaning of our sickness and trial and lead us closer to you as we find comfort in your loving heart.

Let us find joy and peace amidst our suffering, and with eyes of faith, see the blessing and victory that await us.

And then, Father,
after we had been healed,
may we be a witness
of your healing power and
bring glory, honor,
and praise to you.
This we pray in Jesus' Name
through Mary and all the saints. Amen.

4. PRAYER FOR PROTECTION

Lord Jesus. I ask You to protect my family (mention by name) from sickness. from all harm, and from accidents. If any of us has been subjected to any curses, hexes, or spells, I declare these curses, hexes, or spells null and void in the Name of Jesus Christ. If any evil spirits have been sent against us, I decommission you in the Name of Jesus Christ and I send you to Jesus to deal with as He will. Then, Lord, I ask you to send your holy angels to guard and protect all of us. Amen.

5. Te Deum: Prayer of Praise

You are God: we praise you; You are the Lord: we acclaim you; You are the Eternal Father: all creation worships you. To you all angels, all the powers of heaven, cherubim and seraphim, sing in endless praise: Holy, holy, holy, Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. The glorious company of apostles praise you. The noble fellowship of prophets praise you. The white-robed army of martyrs praise you. Throughout the world the holy Church acclaims you: Father, of majesty unbounded, your true and only Son,

worthy of all worship, and the Holy Spirit, advocate and guide. You, Christ, are the king of glory, the eternal Son of of the Father. When you became man to set us free, you did not spurn the Virgin's womb. You overcame the sting of death, and opened the kingdom of heaven to all believers. You are seated at God's right hand in glory. We believe that you will come, and be our judge. Come then, Lord, and help your people, bought with the price of your own blood, and bring us with your saints to glory everlasting. Amen
